

Potton in brief, March 2013

Decisions:

Diane Rypinski Marcoux was appointed deputy mayor for the next 8 months. She will be called to replace if needed.

Opposition to the proposed reduction in governmental compensation for the collection of waste, the use of uranium and the disposition of radioactive waste.

Opposition to the application by Veolia Transdev with the ««Commission des transports du Québec»» to eliminate intercity bus service to and from Potton.

Declaration of April as the Daffodil Month. Citizens are invited to support the Canadian Cancer Society.

Call for applicants for the positions of lifeguard and septic tanks measurement employee.

Hiring of regular seasonal employees at the Vale Perkins wharf, the tourist office, the operation of the grader, the maintenance of parks, the eco-center and administrative support at the Town Hall.

Adoption of rates for non-residents at the Vale Perkins wharf: \$ 375 for the season, \$ 30 for the day (parking, washing and launching) and \$ 10 for parking alone.

Creation of an ad hoc committee to update the municipal emergency plan.

Request for payment of \$ 40,000 corresponding to the first part of a grant of \$ 100,000 for paving the Owl's Head road from the ski centre to the golf course.

Declaration of intent to acquire the Hilmar Krausser and La Falaise roads insofar as municipal road standards will be met.

Award of the contract to purchase bins for waste to Nova Envirocom, the only bidder. This expenditure will be spread over the 2014 and 2015 tax bills.

Bins delivery contract awarded to Enterprises Raymond Cherrier Inc.; delivery will be in May, shortly before the start of the new waste collection in June.

Notice of motion to remove the possibility of minor derogations regarding the structure of roads.

Adoption of the first proposal of a bylaw prohibiting the construction of fixed structures on the shores of lakes and rivers.
