

Potton in brief, June 2011

Recent Decisions

Appointment of Diane Rypinski Marcoux as the municipal representative on the board of "Les Résidences Potton", our senior citizens home.

3 year agreement with the Caisse Desjardins for our financial services.

First of two instalments of \$ 288,168 for the services of the Sûreté du Québec.

Payment to "Le Groupe bénévole municipal de Potton" of \$15 205 which represents residues from grants and the contribution of \$ 10 000 of the Potton Heritage Association for the round barn project.

Renewal of the employment contract of the Director General whose annual salary is increased to \$ 60 000.

As required by the Fire safety coverage program, purchase of a wireless communication system for the fire department and a reservoir for the establishment of a water supply on the property given to the municipality by Mr. Louis Veillon.

Authorization to Owl's Head Development for the burial of wiring on the "chemin du Renard".

Approval of the membership of Eastman in the inter-municipal agreement for adapted and collective transportation of people; this needs to be approved by all participating municipalities in the MRC.

Adoption of a policy on fees for the use of municipal grader on private roads.

Final acceptance of the proposed upgrading of the water infrastructure in the Owl's Head sector and of the final payment of \$ 15 000.

Acceptance of the extension of sewer and water on " le chemin du Mont Owl's Head" and final payment of \$ 10 635.

Adoption of four minor derogations and 8 projects in sectors governed by an architectural integration plan.

Adoption of the second draft bylaw concerning conditional uses on the property of the former Plastiques LPA.

Acceptance for the extension of the Katimavik project for an additional period of one year.

Contribution of \$ 750 to the Optimist Club for the mayor's golf tournament.

Notices of motion for the amendment to the bylaws establishing the urban planning advisory committee (CCU) and employment conditions of municipal employees.

Adoption of bylaws for conditional uses permitted in zone RU-6, the revitalization of buildings in the Town of Mansonville, a program for sketches and the revitalization of commercial signs.

The second Katimavik group will be arriving on July 6. These young Canadians will, as the former group, work in our non-profit organizations to improve our wellbeing. We thank you for welcoming them warmly as you did for the previous group. The management of the Montreal Katimavik is highly impressed by the experience with us so far.
