The Municipal Council informs you

The Municipality wishes you a Happy New Year!

Here are the main topics covered during the municipal session in February:

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION: Authorize the Director General Secretary-Treasurer to participate in the congress of the ADMQ and request support from the landfill charges;

FINANCES: Filing of the accounts and requests for financial assistance from Potton community organizations for 2019 and 2020 respectively and modification to the loan by-law number 2019-457;

STAFF: Authorization to call for candidates for seasonal positions;

RENTAL PROPERTIES AND SPACES: Rates for parking and use of the landing stage at the Vale Perkins wharf;

TRANSPORT AND ROADS: Authorization to call for tenders for the supply of crushed aggregates for the reloading of certain roads;

PUBLIC HYGIENE: Tabling of the annual report of the Program for measuring sludge and scum from septic tanks in 2019, purchase of wheeled bins, addendum to the 2020 contract for the collection and transport of residual materials, renewal of the intermunicipal agreement on access to the Eco-centre

URBAN PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT: PIIA-6: Lot 5 752 556, chemin du Panorama, subdivision and construction of one (1) semi-detached single-family dwelling, PIIA-6: Lot 6 281 180, chemin du Renard, subdivision and construction of one (1) single-family row house (4 units);

LEISURE AND CULTURE: Adoption of Potton's 2020-2030 Cultural and Heritage Policy.

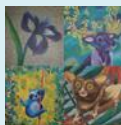
