

Potton in brief, November 2012

Extension until April 15 2013 to the time period granted to the owner of 99 Route de Mansonville for the construction of a fence to conceal the parking area.

Closure of the Town Hall from Saturday December 22 to Wednesday January 2 inclusive.

Issuance of the last two certificates of eligibility for the Renovation Québec program.

Authorization to sign the documents for the takeover of the Maurice Côté Road.

Participation in a new intermunicipal committee whose mission is to ensure the protection of the water quality in the Missisquoi North River. Ms. Alexandra Leclerc, head of Public Hygiene and Environment Protection will represent Potton Township.

Payment for year 2011 of our contribution to Missisquoi North Valley Development Project for the sum of \$ 6,230.

Hiring of Mr.. Richard Lauzon for clearing sidewalks during the 2012-2013 season.

Conditional permission granted to Guy Vincent to implement a skating rink on municipal property at Vale Perkins wharf.

Authorization to sign an intermunicipal agreement with the town of Sutton to enable it to meet the requirements of its Fire Risk Protection Program.

Hiring of Excavation Julien Pouliot Inc. for the removal of snow in the village of Mansonville during the winter 2012-2013.

Acceptance of the subcontractors retained by the main snow removal contractors: Jocelyn Brulotte, on the one hand, and Krista Burke Mr.. Ghislain Daigle are the subcontractors.

Acceptance of the work performed on the Grand Duc Road allowing for the issuance of permits and the provision of some municipal services.

Mandate to BPR for plans and specifications related to correction work on Ruitter Brook near the intersection of West Hill and Ruitter Brook Road.

Authorization to proceed with a call for tenders for waste collection and management of the Ecocentre; tenders will be opened on December 3.

Resolution confirming the intention, when all properties will be served by individual wells, to abandon the waterworks network in the "Immortelles" sector.

Appointment of Mrs. Suzanne Viens to the Planning Advisory Committee and Mrs. Diane Marcoux Rypinski who will replace Mr.. Jacques Hébert.

Minor derogations granted to the Maison Soleil project and to Mrs. M. Coutu and Mr.. S.Mierwinski, the second derogation is conditional on the completion of the drainage works.
